The Corky carafe and Corky Drinking Glasses are sold separately. The Corky Drinking Glasses are sold in packs of four.

# PRODUCTION PROCESS

Corky carafe and drinking glasses are mouthblown and hand-polished. The stopper is made by CNC leathering, then hand-polished for 2 smooth finishing touch.

## MATERIAL

Carafe: glass and granulated cork Drinking glasses: glass

#### **CLEANING AND CARE**

Normal hand wash is recommended. Dishwasher approved at maximum 55 degrees Celsius. Wash Cork Stopper in cold water.

Not suitable for hot beverages.
